Regular maintenance and inspection not only ensures compliance with ANSI A92.22 standards, but also extends the lifespan of your equipment, reduces downtime, and prevents costly repairs.

Safe use for Mobile Elevating Work Platforms (MEWPs)

5.4 Annual Inspection

5.4.1 Owners shall ensure an annual inspection is performed no later than thirteen (13) months from the date of the prior annual inspection. The inspection shall be performed by a person qualified to inspect the specific make and model of MEWP. The inspection shall include all items included in the frequent inspection (see 5.3.3) plus items specified by the manufacturer for an annual inspection, to include manufacturer's bulletins. The inspection shall verify that the MEWP is registered with the MEWP manufacturer and that any open safety-related bulletins are addressed as part of the inspection. The MEWP shall not be placed back into service until all malfunctions and problems identified in the inspection have been corrected.

5.4.2 The owner shall maintain on the MEWP a means, as provided by the manufacturer, to identify the date the last annual inspection was performed and the interval at which annual inspections are required.

Annual routine lift inspection includes:

1

Comprehensive Preventative Maintenance Work
This work ensures safety, extends lift lifespan, and reduces downtime by identifying and addressing worn or damaged components, lubrication issues, pneumatic part leaks, and misaligned limit switches or sensors.

Necessary Repairs and Adjustments
Repairs are made when and if possible, limit switches are calibrated and lubrication systems are inspected and filled to optimize performance.

3

Detailed Reporting and Service Tag Sign-off
A service tag is signed, marked and attached to the lift and a comprehensive service report is provided. Additionally, the Inspection technician can conduct maintenance training for interested personnel.

Routine maintenance and inspections are essential for enhancing safety, extending lift lifespan, and ensuring optimal performance.
